

S.O.A.R. Program

Summer of Academics and Recreation

Whiteside School's S.O.A.R. Program will offer child-care for students in kindergarten through fifth grade. The program will provide children of working parents with a safe, well-supervised program, consisting of academics, recreation, and field trips. **This year the program will be held at Whiteside Middle School.**

- ❖ The program will begin at 8:30 AM and end at 3:00 PM with extended AM and PM hours available for additional fees.
- ❖ SOAR will attend all day field trips on Thursdays and other activities on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. We will remain on campus on Fridays.
- ❖ Students participating in the S.O.A.R. Program will be provided with expectations for daily behavior. Parents will receive 2 written behavior warnings. On the third occurrence, the child will be removed from the program and all paid fees will be forfeited. Gross disobedience or misconduct will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
- ❖ Students will enter and leave S.O.A.R. through the front entrance door. This door will remain locked at all times.
- ❖ Activities will include craft projects, summer reading, recreational sports & games, cooking, water games, movies, academics, field trips, and more.
- ❖ **Students are required to bring a sack lunch each day.** *If your student doesn't have a lunch you will be charged \$5.00 and SOAR will provide a lunch to the student.* A drink will be provided.
- ❖ Students registered for the extended AM program will be provided breakfast. Cereal, Pop Tarts, juice, and milk will be available until 8:30 AM.
- ❖ Students registered for the extended PM program will be provided a snack each day at 4:00 PM.
- ❖ **All students must be signed in and out by an adult when entering or leaving the program.** Our ultimate concern is the safety of every student in the program. Students will be released only to individuals listed on the registration form. Please have ID ready when picking up students.
- ❖ The medication policy as outlined in the Whiteside School handbook will be followed. A student who becomes ill while at the program must be picked up promptly upon notification.
- ❖ **A swimsuit with no metal pieces is required at the water parks.** Make sure that your child has the correct swimwear, sunscreen, and a towel.
- ❖ SOAR is a self-funded program. As such, the program cannot accommodate students who require additional supervision or assistance beyond the standard provided for all participants.

*A \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee will be charged for each child enrolled. All registration fees must be paid by April 15th. Registration fee includes one T-shirt per child.

The first payment is due Wednesday, May 11, 2016.

*All weekly fees must be paid one week in advance on the first day of the week. If payment is not received on the first-day of the week your child may not attend SOAR the next week. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Late Pick-up

Regular Program:

*Parents arriving between 3:05 and 3:15 PM will be charged a \$20.00 late fee and \$1.00 per every minute after 3:15 PM. Late fees must be paid before the child may return to the program.

Extended Program:

*Parents arriving between 6:05 and 6:15 PM will be charged a \$20.00 late fee and \$1.00 per every minute after 6:15 PM. Late fees must be paid before the child may return to the program.

*Three late pick-ups will result in dismissal from the program.

* If a student is still in S.O.A.R.'s care at 6:30 PM, the Sheriff's Department will be contacted to pick up the child and DCFS will be notified. If police intervention is required, the child will be dismissed from the program.

FEES WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE ABSENT.
